Parking

BC Cancer – Parking Lot

Parking is available in the BC Cancer main lot \$2.00/day, payable at parking meter against the building. To park in the lot, a Patient Parking Designation Card is required and must be viewable on your dashboard. This card can be picked up from the main reception desk at Centre for the North.

Underground Garage

Limited underground garage parking is available. To park in the garage a Patient Parking Designation Card is required and must be viewable on your dashboard. This card can be picked up from the main reception desk at Centre for the North.
