

Participating in the BC Cancer Colon Screening Program:

Information for Providers in Northern Health

Starting on July 29th, Northern Health will begin to participate in the BC Cancer Colon Screening Program. Here is a summary of what you and your patients can expect:

1 Recall Notifications for Patients

For patients whose FIT results were copied to the Colon Screening Program prior to July 29, 2024, the Colon Screening Program will mail a reminder letter with a laboratory requisition to patients, on behalf of the provider on record, when they are due for their next FIT.

What this means for patients: Patients with an active provider on record will receive a requisition for FIT when they are due to screen. If a patient changes their residential address to another address in BC, they can update their information through AddressChangeBC (www.addresschange.gov.bc.ca) to ensure the requisition is sent to the correct location.

2 Facilitated Referrals to Colonoscopy

If a patient has an abnormal (positive) FIT result, the Colon Screening Program will facilitate a referral for a colonoscopy to the patient's Health Authority. The Health Authority will contact the patient, assess their medical history, provide information on colonoscopy, provide preparation instructions, and book a colonoscopy procedure, if appropriate. Some patients may require chart review or consultation by a colonoscopist prior to the colonoscopy.

What this means for your practice: If a patient's FIT result is abnormal, you will no longer need to manually refer them for a colonoscopy. You will receive a notice of referral indicating where the patient was referred.

Notifications for Providers

To help you support your patients with routine colon screening and any recommended follow-up, the Colon Screening Program will notify you:

- When a patient is due for screening; and
- When a patient is referred for colonoscopy.

You will receive these notifications through Excelleris.
